Transportation Plan for COVID Phase IV

In order to offer students, faculty and staff safety, the following transportation plan will be in effect until Illinois moves into Phase V of COVID Recovery.

- Home District will certify student is COVID symptom free and without temperature at 100.4° or above prior to allowing them on the bus assigned to travel to/from the Career Center and verify student has a mask. No students allowed in the Career Center without a mask (face covering).
- Students transported to the Career Center from their home district will remain on the bus until their allotted timeslot. No students allowed in the building until the bell rings.
- Only one (1) bus will be allowed to disembark at the front entrance at a time. Bus will then move away from the front entrance to allow the next bus to disembark.
- Students will enter KACC main upper entrance only and walk immediately to their classroom following the established walkway path noted by arrows on the floors.
- Upon arrival, students will have their temperature taken and asked to provide their self-certification.
- KACC staff will be in hallway during arrival and departure times to assist students in maintaining social distancing.
- Students who have a driving pass will remain in their car until all busses have disembarked and then enter the main entryway and go immediately to their classroom.
- Any student who arrives late for class will have temperate taken and self-certification at time of entry.
